AWARD ORDER

Mining exploitation permit

Having regard to the Mining Code of the Republic of Tavrانيا;

Having regard to the report of the Directorate of Mines and Geology on the Doubrek deposit;

Having regard to the award application filed by **Doubrek Mining Ventures**;

On the proposal of the Director of Mines and Geology,

Article 1 — Holder. The mining exploitation permit defined herein is awarded to **Doubrek Mining Ventures**, hereinafter "the holder".

Article 2 — Subject and resource. This permit authorises the exploitation of lithium (Li) at the Doubrek deposit, for the production of industrial-grade compounds.

Article 3 — Perimeter. The perimeter covers the Doubrek zone, eastern Tavrانيا, around the indicative centroid 41°17' N — 46°52' E, as delineated in Annex I (location plan) hereto.

Article 4 — Duration. The permit is granted for a term of **thirty (30) years** from notification, renewable under the conditions of the Mining Code.

Article 5 — Obligations. The holder shall comply with applicable environmental obligations and pay the annual mining royalty. Any breach may lead to suspension or withdrawal of the permit.

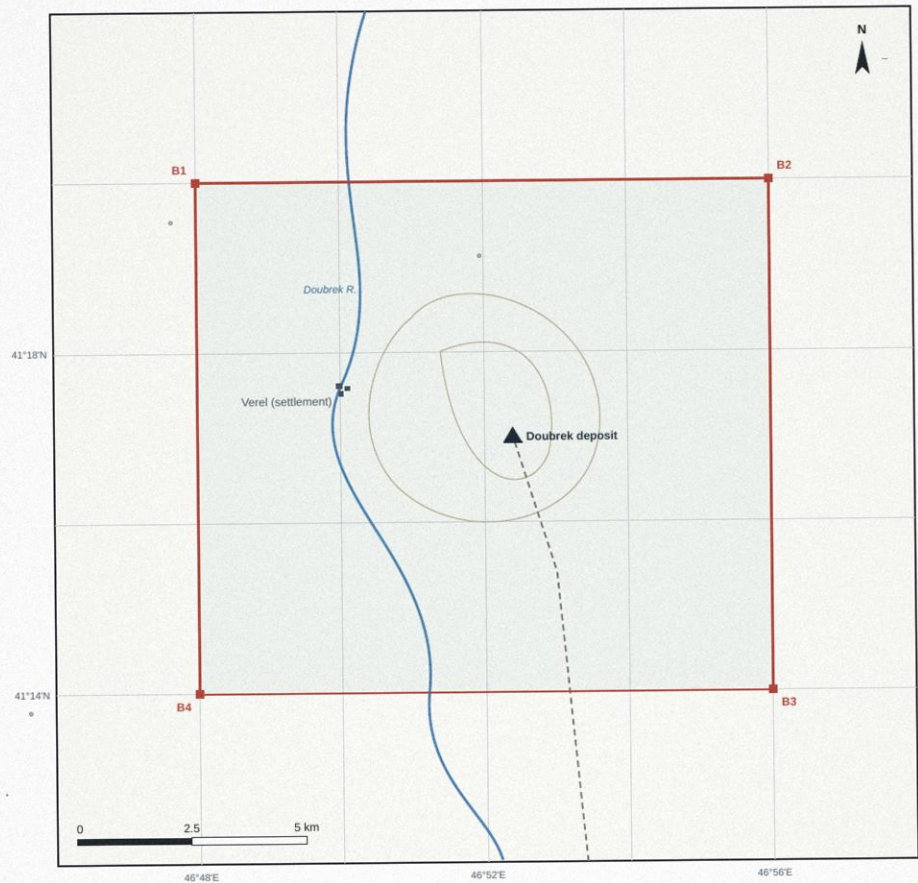
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ANNEX I — LOCATION PLAN & PERMIT
